"His Life" - I Am the Door to the Sheep

Introduction:

- I. All decisions come from one of 2 standards: self or not self
- II. Jesus says that not self is the right standard
- III. Jesus claims to be the door — John 10:9

Discussion:

- I. As the Door, Jesus Restricts Entrance
 - A. Jesus restricts entrance generally.
 - a. No entrance for sub-par righteousness, just claiming you know God, & not fully converting.
 - B. Jesus restricts entrance specifically
 - a. No entrance for the hard-hearted, unbelievers, and sin.
- II. As the Door, Jesus Permits Entrance
 - A. Jesus permits entrance generally.
 - a. Entrance permitted with faithfulness, diligence, and doing God's commands.
 - B. Jesus permits entrance specifically
 - a. One must obey the Gospel and continue to grow in their faith..

Conclusion:

- I. **Rev 21:27** But nothing unclean will ever enter it, nor anyone who does what is detestable or false, but only those who are written in the Lamb's book of life.
